787 MRC units


193,730 volunteers

- ★ The following units supported COVID-19 vaccination sites: the **Montgomery County Medical Reserve Corps (MD)**, the **Franklin County and Columbus Medical Reserve Corps (OH)**, the **Denton County Medical Reserve Corps (TX)**, the **Passaic County Medical Reserve Corps (NJ)**, the **Philadelphia Medical Reserve Corps (PA)**, the **Galveston County Medical Reserve Corps (TX)**, the **Milford Medical Reserve Corps (CT)**, the **Schuyler County Medical Reserve (NY)**, the **Contra Costa County Medical Reserve Corps (CA)**, and the **Holmes County MRC (OH)**.
- ★ In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, medical volunteers with the **Medical Reserve Corps of El Paso County (CO)** provided telehealth services to individuals in homeless isolation shelters.
- ★ The **Washington County Medical Reserve Corps (OR)** supported a free flu vaccination community clinic, which served vulnerable and at-risk community members and enabled volunteers to prepare for upcoming COVID-19 vaccine clinics.
- ★ The **Linn County Medical Reserve Corps (OR)** helped operate a drive-through COVID-19 testing site.
- ★ The **NM Integrative Wellness MRC (NM)** operated a COVID-19 warm line for MRC responders needing emotional support after deployment.
- ★ The **Marion County Medical Reserve Corps (FL)** participated in training for COVID-19 vaccination.
- ★ The **Chittenden County Medical Reserve Corps (VT)** assisted with a COVID-19 surveillance study.
